Situated in the heart of its surrounding community, the lodge offers an exceptional platform to experience this part of Lesotho - whether through local community engagement (via the Malealea Development Trust) or through adventures on foot, horseback or mountain bike.
Rooms	A variety of rooms to suit all budgets from camping to basic huts to comfortable ensuite rondavels. Accommodation is basic but comfortable. Water comes from the local spring, power from solar panels and hot water from a combined solar / gas system.
Facilities	The restaurant offers nourishing meals served buffet style. There is a bar and lounge area, with a deck and fire pit to enjoy on the cool evenings. The local choir and band make music each evening out on the lawn-with-a-view: an excellent place to stargaze on your way to bed once the lights go out.
Security	Lodge is fenced with 24 hour controlled access security.

Tour Bus

The exact vehicle will depend on the final size of the group. The vehicle for this visit will be a local bus with comfortable seats fitted with seat belts, air-conditioning, stereosystem and large windows. There is a fire extinguisher and First Aid Kit on board, and all drivers hold a South African Professional Drivers' Permit (PDP).

Should transport be required while in Lesotho, we have a local provider that we can charter in to transport groups around the Malealea Valley, to Ribaneng, or to Matsieng / Maseru.

We hold copies of insurance, vehicle licence & roadworthy, any required transport permits, and driver PDPs for every vehicle that we use. We take road safety extremely seriously.

The "work" on this activation visit will be tailored to suit all comers! No previous experience of the Wonderbag is necessary. Many of you that read this document will already be familiar with this extraordinary invention. For those that are new to the Wonderbag it is a thermal bag which cooks food with very little work and very little energy. While this is helpful for us leading busy lives in the developed world, (especially if we care for our planet - for it dramatically reduces climate changing gases) in Africa it can be utterly transformational for its users. This visit seeks to firstly: introduce us to the Wonderbag and its fabricators; we then familiarize ourselves with its use; introduce it to communities that do not know it exists and finally consult with community members that have used it to learn of its impact and see if any lessons can be learned in sharing it with others. You will be guided in these interactions and shall meet some wonderful people, and we hope you will return with Africa's Gift in your heart and become an ambassador for Wonderbags!

Food

During your time with us, our aim is to expose you to many aspects of South African life and culture - including food. On this visit, you will have the chance to experience different local cuisines from the classic South African Braai to the gentle spices of Cape Malay cooking, traditional African fare and stunning seafood fresh from the Indian Ocean.

All breakfasts, most dinners and some packed lunches will be provided by the accommodation establishments and will be familiar to you. The quality of meals often varies depending on the type of lodge and its location (access to market). Where meals are not included, your guide will organise a table at a local restaurant where you will have a menu to choose from.

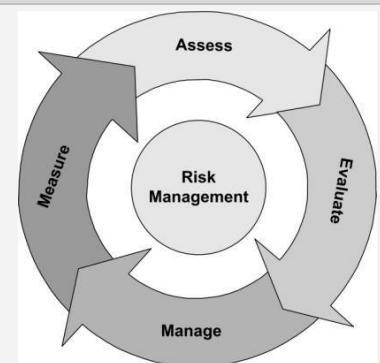
Drinks, snacks and so on are readily available at your own cost and are often similar to what you will find back home as well as discovering the local specialities ☺.
